Honors Program provides
accomplished students an
opportunity for advanced
interdisciplinary study and
engagement with a faculty
mentor on a research or
scholarly project.

The program consists of a three-semester commitment, beginning with a 3-unit honors seminar taken in the second semester of junior year.

This is followed by a 3-unit independent study with a faculty mentor to work on a research project in the first semester of senior year.

Finally, a 3-unit honors colloquium in the second semester of their senior year serves as a culminating experience where they make a public presentation of their research or scholarly project.

Graduate Dean's Medalist Mauricio Soriano, Plant Science

The Santa Maria native is a first-generation college student with a 3.58 GPA and the son of Salvadoran immigrants who fled during its civil war to the United States. Upon graduating from high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Army as an infantryman and served two combat tours in Afghanistan while stationed at Fort Carson, Colorado, After his honorable discharge. Soriano pursued a B.A. in biological sciences at the University of Colorado, Colorado Springs, where he discovered a passion for plants. This interest led him to the Central Valley to conduct research with faculty Dr. Sharon Benes that supports the environment, agriculture and the community. Their project uses satellite imagery to estimate forage yield in highsalinity soils irrigated with drainage reuse water — an approach that promotes water conservation but can lead to soil degradation. He was awarded the Gerald O. Mott Graduate Student Award by the American Society of Agronomy, where he also serves as chair of the Military Veterans in Agriculture Specialty Group.



Undergraduate Dean's Medalist Vanessa Jauregui-Salgado, Agricultural Business

The Fresno native, a first-generation college student and daughter of Mexican immigrants, earned a B.S. degree in three years with a 4.0 GPA, which included a minor in precision agriculture technology. She competed on student marketing business case study projects at industry conferences, and served as president of the Agricultural Business Club — National Agri-Marketing Association Chapter. She also served as vice president of the Minorities in Agriculture, Natural Resources and Related Sciences Chapter and helped organize the Agricultural Business Department annual banquet and Agribusiness Management Conference. She also participated in a study abroad class in Spain that involved wine market and consumer sensory analysis last summer, then learned about crop, soil, pest and irrigation management as an agronomy intern for Reiter Affiliated Companies. She currently works with the California Agave Council and collects industry research, assists with grants, and develops educational materials to attract new agave growers in the Central Valley.
